Terrine of Herb Fed Chicken, Cauliflower Textures, Curry, Raisin Puree

*Originally named Poulet Reine Elizabeth, Coronation Chicken was first served during Her Majesty's coronation banquet in 1953.*

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Smoked Salmon Parfait

Pickled Cucumber, Caviar Butter Sauce

Caves D'Esclans Whispering Angel, France, 2020

Known as Royal Fish, The Queen owns all Dolphins, Whales and Sturgeons within 3 miles of the British Coast. None are included in this dish, of course, however the Queen is particularly fond of Scottish Smoked Salmon.

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### **Nidderdale Venison**

Broad Bean, Baby Onion, Dauphinoise Potato, Creamed Whiskey Sauce

Château Perron, Lalande-de-Pomerol, 2016

*Despite the Queen eating lamb at her 1953 Coronation Banquet, The Queen's favourite meat is actually venison. Rumour has it one of her favourite meals is a venison burger albeit served with Cranberry Sauce and not tomato ketchup!*

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Bombe Glacée Royal

Mint Chocolate Chip Parfait, Aerated Milk Chocolate

It's long been known that the Queen has a sweet tooth, particularly when it comes to chocolate, so it's no surprise that her go-to dessert is a rich, mint and chocolatey delight known as a Bombe Glacée Royale. Her Majesty is such a huge fan that a fruity version was even served at her wedding in 1947

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### **Victoria Sponge**

Warm Poppyseed Cake, Strawberry Parfait, Vanilla & White Chocolate Cremeux

Dubonnet Martini

*Queen Victoria was the Great Great Grandmother of Queen Elizabeth. In 1953 the United Kingdom was still subject to food rationing and the Queen opted for Strawberries and Friandises (Small Cakes) to round off her Coronation Banquet. Sugar rationing ended in September 1953.*
